

Well Pet Dog and Cat Clinic Hours

There may be a wait for this service

You may schedule within 24 hours of the desired day or arrive as a “walk in”.

Services are offered only at the Chatham Animal Hospital, location 105 Oceana Place, Cary at this time.

This service is intended for Clients:

- (1) That believe their pet has no ailments
- (2) Are in search of a cost effective means to update vaccinations and routine lab tests (heartworm and intestinal parasite screens)
- (3) Understands that this is a well pet service and therefore cannot address any issues other than the well dog or cat.
